**IMPORTATION AND CLEARANCE OF SECOND HAND MOTOR  
VEHICLES**

The General Public and all importers of Second Hand Motor Vehicles are hereby informed that, with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2012, customs clearance of second hand motor vehicles shall be done at border stations. This therefore means that second hand motor vehicles shall no longer be allowed to proceed on transit bond for onward clearance at inland stations. However, Customs Clearance Certificates shall continue being issued at Blantyre Port, Lilongwe Port and Mzuzu Port.

The General Public and all Importers of Second Hand Motor vehicles are further advised to ensure that proper arrangements for Customs Clearance of used vehicles at the border stations are made to avoid inconveniences.
